BIRD REPORTS Help!

With the passing of each month our Bird Records data base becomes more valuable as a resource to study the distribution and abundance of birds in northwestern Louisiana. With ten years of data we have enough to detect changes in our local bird fauna.

In order for anyone to use our data effectively we must have accurate locality and date information along with the numbers of birds observed. It is very important that the locality be as specific as possible. If your observations are from your residence or some other specific address then the location is precise and identifiable. If your observations are away from town then give the location as carefully as possible from a definite landmark (for example, "3.4 miles east of Bellvue" or "Jacob's Memorial Nature Park" or "intersection of Mt. Zion rd. and Linwood Ave."). Always include the parish and date on your data sheets.

Do not use a location that cannot be identified to a specific place. A locality stated as "South on LA. 1" tells the reader that the location was somewhere in Louisiana between the Arkansas state line north of Rodessa and Grand Isle, a distance of about 420 miles that includes at least ten different habitats. Thanks to someone for a good example. You may think this is silly; however, your colleague in birding should not have to guess if the bird was seen 5 miles south of Shreveport or 50 miles south of Alexandria! If the person would have included the parish it would have reduced the mystery locality to a mere 60 miles.

If you can indicate numbers of birds seen on your outing, do so. A check mark is interpreted as a one! Aren't you proud that your sighting of 89 **Wood Storks** is recorded for posterity to enjoy as, "1 **Wood Stork**." The other person that saw the 89 **Wood Storks** will wonder where you were when the other 88 flew by!

Most of the bird records are entered in the data base by volunteers, or sometimes a student worker in the Museum. This time-consuming job is vitally important to the quality of the data base. The computer operator should not have to try to unravel your locality or take time to figure out what parish you were in. It is the observer's responsibility to state the location accurately so others can find the place many years from now.

Please help improve the quality of our data base by filling out the bird record sheets completely. Give a precise locality, the date, the parish, and the numbers of birds seen. This will greatly assist me and the other volunteers who compile your bird records.

Extralimital Dates: Doves through Owls, Kingfisher, Woodpeckers

This is the seventh in a series of reports on extralimital dates for migratory birds in our area. It is based exclusively on the Bird Study Group Bird Report data base. The intent of this series is to alert birders of the approximate arrival and departure dates of migrants (based on our data base) and of times during the year in need of better documentation. In some cases, permanent residents (PE) are included if annual data is incomplete. At least six dates (if available) are given for each species. For summer residents (SU) the first three dates are the earliest arrival dates in the spring and the last three dates are the latest departure dates in the fall. For winter residents (WI), the first three dates are the latest departure dates in the spring and the last three are the earliest arrival dates in the fall. The last column gives months for which additional data is needed. For non-resident migrants the first line (SP) contains the earliest three arrival and latest three departure dates for the spring and the second line (FA) gives the earliest arrival and latest departure dates for the fall migration. In some cases fewer than three dates are available for a given category. Accidentals (AC) contain only one or two records.
