Louisiana for birding and mingling with the Lafayette bird club (LABA). Please sign up at the May meeting or contact me by Tuesday, May 11, so I may RSVP to LABA for Saturday night dinner reservations and for the Sunday picnic. Participants are welcome to join us for either or both days. Let me know your plans when you sign up.

#### Itinerary:

Saturday – Vermilion Parish rice country south of Rayne for shorebirds and others. Sightings last year included Black-bellied Plover, Dunlin, Ruddy Turnstone, Buff-bellied Sandpiper, Whimbrel, White-faced and Glossy Ibis, Peregrine Falcon, Swainson's Hawk, and Broad-winged Hawk. We'll stop somewhere for lunch, probably at Suire's Grocery in Kaplan. This day will be primarily car birding. We will have reservations for dinner at a local restaurant.

Sunday – Sherburne WMA/Atchafalaya NWR and Whiskey Bay Road. We'll join LABA, the Lafayette bird club, for their annual field trip and picnic. The morning's birding will be followed by the picnic at Jim Delahoussaye's home on the Atchafalaya River. Jim has Prothonotary Warblers nesting in his yard. Last year's list included Swallow-tailed Kite, White-Eyed and Red-eyed Vireo, Acadian Flycatcher, Northern Parula, Swainson's Warbler, Hooded Warbler, Chestnut-sided Warbler, Yellow-breasted Chat, and Painted Bunting. Expect light walking.

# DAPHNE PRAIRIE, TX, GRASSHOPPER SPARROW, BELL'S VIREO, WILDFLOWERS

Daphne Prairie is a 1,000-acre unplowed remnant of Texas' Tallgrass Prairie located three hours from Shreveport near Mount Vernon, Texas. As many as 300 different kinds of native grasses and wildflowers can be found in an acre of virgin prairie and Daphne should be in full bloom during our visit. **Grasshopper Sparrows** 

will be singing from the fence posts and **Bell's Vireo** will be nesting.

*Itinerary*:

Saturday afternoon. – Field trip to Mount Vernon's Dupree Park.

Saturday evening (Tentative) – Cocktail reception at the Old Church Inn hosted by B.F. Hicks.

Sunday morning – Field trip to Daphne Prairie. Sunday afternoon – To be determined.

The standard rate for visiting Daphne is \$50. However, because of the large turnout for the BSG November trip to Daphne, B.F. Hicks, the co-owner of Daphne, has offered us a special one-time rate, so the cost of this trip is \$40 per person, not including lodging or meals, \$35 of which will go to preserving the prairie and \$5 of which will go to support the activities of the BSG.

# Bishop's Point, Lock and Dam 5, Carmel, and Smithport Lake Outing

Eighteen BSG members and visitors went birding at the above locations on March 27, 2004. The weather was delightful and all of the birds we had hoped to see were present at the expected locations. That makes it fun to be the leader because nobody is disappointed.

We traveled south on LA Hwy 1 to a half-mile north of Yearwood Road, where a large flock of **American** 

Golden-Plovers had been seen. We counted 67 as they walked, fed, rested and occasionally flew short distances. It would have been nice if they all had flown at once because I always enjoy seeing the tight flock, and unison maneuvering of these large birds. A mile or more down the road we scoped out the Greater and Lesser Yellowlegs, Blue-winged Teal, Gadwall, Tricolored Heron, Little Blue Heron, and listened to a Belted Kingfisher belting out his rattled call. We had a mystery bird here that I really don't want to mention because to do so admits that I have fallen off my pedestal. To me it looked like a dark brown Greater Yellowlegs. To others it looked like a Stilt Sandpiper. Its bill was as long as the bill of a yellowlegs, no eyestripe, and very light under-wings. It flew right over us, but offered no defining markings, and no call that I could hear. We voted, as democratic birding organizations must, and the non-committed vote won by a huge majority.

At Lock and Dam 5 we went down the gravel road south, and the **American White Pelicans** put on a glorious show as they sailed overhead almost within reach of a butterfly net. The **Double-crested Cormorants** were paled by comparison. Large numbers of **Cliff Swallows** again are nesting along the south end of the lock. I once had a pair **Cave Swallows** nesting a Lock and Dam 1, so be sure to look for them here. Many **Barn Swallows** and **Purple Martins** were also present.

Moving on to Bishop's Point we saw Forsters' Tern, Herring Gull, Ring-billed Gull, and American Coot. A few Tree Swallows were far out over the water's of Pool 5, and I was able to scope up one Spotted Sandpiper. I'm sure it was difficult for some of us to remain bound to the land, when we knew there were many species unseen only 2 miles up the river in an area accessible by boat only. We had lunch here at the pavilion of this new and very nice facility.

We had more Yellowlegs, **Pectoral Sandpipers**, ducks, and one **Solitary Sandpiper** farther down Hwy 1, on the way to Carmel. The main attraction was the Rock Chapel at Carmel, built about 1890 by monks. Yellow fever caused severe death losses and the abandoning of the colony. I think it moved to Germantown north of Minden, LA. We did see **Brown-headed Nuthatches** in Carmel.

People were happy, snacking on leftovers from lunch, birding and enjoying the dogwoods, redbuds, wild jasmine, red buckeye and wisteria blooming. We had one last stop. At Smithport Lake Dam the butterflies were putting on a better show than the birds. We did see both target birds, **Northern Parula** and **Yellow-throated Warbler**. I learned that I can still hear the high pitched call of the parula. I was afraid I had lost

that ability, and that it was only present in memory. With that good news I bid the group farewell, although I had the opinion many were reluctant to leave one of the most picturesque places in northern Louisiana, the Spanish Moss draped Cypress Swamp at Smithport Lake.

#### A Weekend in Cameron Parish

The LOS spring meeting was held in Cameron Friday, April 23 through Sunday, April 25, 2004. Fourteen members of the BSG attended this weekend of LOS meetings and birding. I went for the birds but also enjoyed the meetings. I birded with Mac Hardy. Our goal was small, to see Rose-breasted Grosbeaks, and our results were good, a total of 94 species on Saturday including the Rose-breasted Grosbeaks. Unexpected afternoon rain resulted in not only wet shoes but also six species of warblers in one tree (Chestnut-sided Warbler, Black and White Warbler, Tennessee Warbler, Yellow Warbler, Black-throated Green Warbler, and Swainson's Warbler). The highlight bird for most of us over the weekend was Cape May Warbler at the Peveto Woods Sanctuary. Mac and I had missed it on Saturday, so on Sunday we went for another look. Upon our arrival, we were told, to our disappointment, that no one had seen it on Sunday. We joined the Trahans and the Martins in looking for the Cape May Warbler in the "warbler tree." Luckily it appeared. Not only did it appear, but it perched directly over our heads in plain view. It did not take long for the crowd of anxious birders to assemble.

Other good trip birds included: Black Tern, American Avocet, Bobolink, Indigo Bunting, and Painted Bunting. Among the shorebirds we identified: Semipalmated Plover, Piping Plover, Black-necked Willet. Stilt. Whimbrel, Ruddy Turnstone, Sanderling, Least Sandpiper, Dunlin, Caspian Tern, Royal Tern, Sandwich Tern, Least Tern, and Black Skimmers. An American Oyster Catcher was nesting near the Cameron parish/Texas border. We did not see this bird. After hearing where it was, we realized that not only did we drive past it but also ate our lunch 100 yards from it with out ever seeing it. Well, it just proves you can't see everything even if you are trying to, especially if you are hungry.

One thing that impressed me on this trip, other than the warblers, was the number of **Boat-tailed Grackles** (and even a few **Great-tailed Grackles**) in Cameron parish. They were absolutely everywhere. The males were in full mating mode, displaying for every grackle to

see. They called and displayed (head up, tail up, feathers fanned) on every imaginable perch telephone lines, posts, and roads.

Next spring I encourage you to go the LOS meeting in Cameron. It is a great birding weekend with great migrant birds and fellow birders. The LOS also meets in Cameron in the fall. That is a good meeting to get acquainted with the area so that you will be ready for the spring.

#### A Call to Serve the BSG

# **Make Checklists from your BSG Bird Database** by Mac Hardy

A new report (SPLIST.REP) format for the BSG Bird Database is available that will generate a species list (a field checklist of names) for any group in our database. Contact me if you want the new report format or want to start using the BSG database.

You can use this report for any field or combination of fields in the database. For example, all species from Soda Lake on a certain date or by a certain observer.

This report should give us a much better ability to find areas that need more birding exploration.

#### **Bird Records Notes**

I suggest that users of the BSG Bird Database use Macro C when entering new bird records in your database, rather than typing in the species abbreviation each time. Use of the macro (Macro C) to enter new bird records provides two very important functions for maintaining the quality of the BSG Bird Database. First, it gets the correct name of the species from the names database on your disk. This prevents misspellings and typographical errors (such as capitalization or omitting hyphens). Second, it also gets the correct sequence number. The sequence number is what allows any report that lists names to list them in the correct AOU sequence.

Use of the macro eliminates the need to find and correct names and/or sequence numbers and saves me a lot of time when the bird report is being prepared.

#### **Minutes of the Board Meeting**

A Virtual Meeting on the Internet Ending April 9, 2003

Board members contacted by email were Mac Hardy, Jeff Trahan, Nancy Menasco, Lily Poole, Larry Raymond, Jerry Bertrand, Amanda Crnkovic, Jean Trahan, Hubert Hervey, Dennis Forshee, Dan Weber, Linda Adrion, and Michele Andrews. Committee members and others contacted were Rosemary Seidler, Jim Ingold, and Barney Poole.

**Treasurer's Report** – Jean Trahan reported income during the last month of \$266.00 and expenses of \$83.81. The club has \$3,129.12 cash in the bank, \$250.44 at the post office for mailing newsletters, and \$250.65 at the LSUS printing office for printing newsletters. The total assets are \$3,630.21.

**Old Business** – Sarah Hancock and Linda Adrion selected a winner for the BSG regional science fair award. The winner was Robert Yokem with the project "Safe Guarded Birdhouse." Lily ordered and picked up a plaque for \$37.17 that will be presented to Robert at the next meeting.

New Business – Nominating committee. The nominating committee is composed of Amanda Crnkovic, Lily Poole, Nancy Menasco, and Rosemary Seidler. Board members whose terms are up are Dan Weber, Nancy Menasco, Larry Raymond, Roy Bott and John McBride. Dan Weber has said that he has chosen not to return to the board. Nancy has volunteered to

return to the board and has suggested that we ask at the next meeting if anyone is interested in serving.

**Bird Hot Spots** – Larry Raymond reported that the Hot Spots publication is close to complete. He expects it to be finished in a few weeks.

**Beginning Birders** – Dennis Forshee said that he conducts bimonthly bird walks for birders. He will begin providing an information packet prepared in advance that might include a current BSG newsletter, Wild Bird Center (WBC) newsletter, field checklist, BSG business card, WBC business card, and other free literature. Dennis is open to suggestions as to what to include. The idea is to generate interest in the club and bring in new members.

**Field Trips** – Nancy Menasco reported that the date for the North Louisiana Birding Challenge had to be changed due to conflicts on May 8. The next open date is May 29. Nancy reported on upcoming field trips: Eddie Jones Park on April 10, Noah Tyson Park on April 18, Louisiana Ornithological Society meeting on April 23-25, and the North American Migration Count on May 8.

**Membership** – Lily Poole reported 97 paid accounts. The club also added three more Libraries as gratis accounts.

**Programs** – Jerry Bertrand reported that Rhonda Clay will present a program about owls for the April meeting. Rhonda is the Park Naturalist at Walter B. Jacobs Park. Matt White will present the May program, but Jerry does not have a program title yet.

Tern Save – Dan Weber, Nancy Menasco, Lily Poole, and Barney Poole met March 30. Dan has several contacts with USFW and the Corps of Engineers that he would like Hubert to get in touch with. It seems that these agencies have Hubert's data but need encouragement in acting on behalf of the Red River Least Terns. Lily and Barney Poole have posted Hubert's publications on the Least Tern on the BSG web site.

**BSG Website** – Barney Poole is concerned that for various reasons, the club will lose its gratis account at Softdisk. Barney recommends that we seek a paid hosting provider and register a top level domain for the BSG website. Both www.birdstudygroup.org or www.birdstudygroup-sport.org are available at this time. Barney will check pricing for hosting services at national Internet Service Providers that have good histories of

service to get cost estimates for hosting for the BSG as well as top level domain naming options and pricing.

#### **Minutes of the Regular Meeting**

April 13, 2004, 7:00 p.m., Museum of Life Sciences at LSUS

**Program** – Rhonda Clay from Walter B. Jacobs Nature Park spoke on owls. She brought Winkie who is a Barred Owl and Tiger who is a Great Horned Owl to help entertain and educate the group about owls.

**Treasurer's Report** – Jean Trahan reported income during the last month of \$266.00 and expenses of \$83.81. The club has \$3,129.12 cash in the bank, \$250.44 at the post office for mailing newsletters, and \$250.65 at the LSUS printing office for printing newsletters. The total assets are then \$3,630.21.

Science Fair Award – Robert Yokem won the BSG science fair award for a project concerning birds. Robert's project title was "Protected Bluebird House." He made an electronic device that would emit a loud sound to protect bluebird houses from snakes or squirrels. Robert was awarded with a plaque.

**Tern Save** – Hubert Hervey asked for approval to use the club's letterhead and name to send letters to get help saving the **Least Tern**. Larry Raymond moved that the club allow Hubert to write letters in the name of the BSG. The motion was seconded and approved by the membership.

**Field Trips** – Nancy Menasco reported that there were openings on the Fort Hood field trip on May 1-2 because some people and dropped out. Other field trips are the following: Noah Tyson Park on April 18, and South Louisiana rice fields on May 15-16. She reported that the North Louisiana Birding Challenge has been moved to May 29 because of conflicts.

Hot Spots – Larry Raymond reported that the Hot Spots publication is almost ready. He said that it is 54 pages. LSUS can reproduce 250 copies for \$243.80 or with a better binding for \$501.25. Larry recommended the version with the better binding. He has distributed copies to the editorial board and has asked that they be returned with corrections as soon as possible.

**Programs** – Jerry Bertrand said that Matt White will present the next program.

### BIRD REPORT – compiled April 28, 2004

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer's initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds they observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.
