THE BIG SIT!

The 12th Annual Big Sit officially begins at midnight and ends 24 hours later. The Big Sit was founded by the New Haven, CT, Bird Club and is hosted by *Birdwatcher's Digest*. Participants count from within a 17-foot diameter circle. Swarovski Optik donates \$500 to the team who gets the "Golden Bird," a bird selected by random drawing from all birds sighted. The winning circle chooses a non-profit environmental-based organization to be the recipient of the \$500. This will be the fourth BSG Big Sit at C. Bickham Dickson Park. Last year, our count total was 70 species, up from 68 species in 2002 and 53 in 2001.

Sitters may come and go at will. Beginning birders are especially encouraged to participate in this event. This is an excellent opportunity to observe behavior and patterns of bird activity over a day's time. Park in the parking lot next to the old horse barn. Signs will lead you to our circle. The circle will be in the field around the first curve of the gated road that leads to the back of the park. We will have access to the restrooms by the barn. Between the Raindrops

Torrential rains had left the area saturated and soggy. Undaunted by the forecast for more of the same, several Bird Study Group members spent the weekend of May 15-16 wandering the highways and byways of Acadia, Vermilion, St Martin, Iberville, and Lafayette Parishes. Shorebirds were the target on Saturday and, unlike normal years where shorebirds, waders, and ducks are concentrated in a limited number of wet areas, this year water was everywhere and the birds were spread out over said "everywhere." However, led by Dave Patton and Judith O'Neale, we solved that problem by going everywhere. In an attempt to keep track of what parish we were in for the parish list competition, we tried to follow the twistings and turnings on our map. At one point, after believing we'd been in Vermilion Parish for quite some time, someone figured out that we were actually back in Acadia Parish. Determining how we got there, how long we'd been there, and what birds we'd seen since we crossed the parish line was lots of fun. Despite the parish confusion, several of us picked up one or more life birds, including a much-studied group of **Baird's Sandpipers**. Other birds seen included all three ibis species, **White Ibis**, **White-faced Ibis**, and **Glossy Ibis**, **Black-bellied Plover**, **Whimbrel**, **Ruddy Turnstone** and **Dunlin**. Proving that old adage, "BSG'ers spread sunshine wherever they go," the rain showers held off on Saturday the entire time we were birding.

Sunday was to be the occasion of the annual Sherburne WMA/Atchafalaya NWR field trip and picnic for LABA, the Lafayette bird club. Due to the uncertain conditions of LA 975, the main birding road, and the potential number of vehicles that might have to be towed out of the mud, the field trip had to be cancelled. But this didn't stop our hardy little band. We rendezvoused early Sunday morning at the southern end of Whiskey Bay Road (LA 975) just off I-10 and were able to bird as far north as Happytown Road with no problems and no rain

either until we were on our way back to Lafayette. **Wild Turkey**, **Prothonotary Warbler**, **Hooded Warbler**, **Common Yellowthroat**, **Yellow-breasted Chat**, **Painted Bunting**, and **Wood Thrush** are a few of the birds we found here. Of course, a visit to this area is never complete without a **Swallow-tailed Kite** sighting and we were not disappointed as two glided above us. What the road conditions were like further north we didn't discover as by then it was time to head to Lafayette to Judith O'Neale's house. Lunch had been moved to Judith's because of flooding in Jim Delahoussaye's yard, the original picnic site. Although we missed getting to see the amazing numbers of **Ruby-throated Hummingbirds** at Jim's (he estimated there could be as many as 400 hanging out around his yard), we did view a wonderful hummingbird video, made by an acquaintance of Judith's, which included many South and Middle American species.

Everyone took the opportunity at one time or another to visit the rookery at Lake Martin, apparently, in the nick of time, as the week after we were there, the road around the lake was closed due to high water. In addition to seeing **Anhinga**, **Roseate Spoonbill**, and the nine heron and egret species that nest there, including **Tricolored Heron**, **Black-crowned Heron**, and **Yellow-crowned Night-Heron**, Jerry and I had a **Barred Owl** perch just above us in a big oak tree beside the road.

BSG'ers making the journey south were Rosemary Seidler, Ann McLaurin, Nancy Menasco, Vicki LeFevers, Jerry Bertrand, and Linda Adrion. Thanks to the Lafayette group for their usual hospitality. We'll be back!

North Louisiana Birding Challenge

On Saturday, May 29, 2004, the Bird Study Group narrowly edged out the intrepid birders of the Northeast Louisiana Bird Club of Monroe to win the inaugural North Louisiana Birding Challenge by a species count of 113 to 107. Gerry Click of the Monroe club, the instigator of the challenge, crunched the numbers to report that 130 different species were counted between the two clubs, an excellent total for a date when most spring migrants have already passed through northern Louisiana. 90 species were seen by both clubs; Shreveport had 23 unique species and Monroe had 17, including an enviable **Swallow-tailed Kite** at the Ouachita WMA.

In an effort to leave no tree unperused, no body of water unexplored, and no field unscanned, birders

combed the far reaches of Caddo Parish, looking for those elusive species that might put us over the top. From the bayous to the back roads, from Cross Lake to Caddo Lake to the Red River, in yards from Blanchard to Spring Ridge, BSG'ers searched high and low. Even downtown Shreveport was covered as a stakeout on McNeil Street yielded a family of **Barn Owls**. Participants birded while working and while playing. **Ruddy Duck, Least Bittern, Bald Eagle, Laughing Gull, Barred Owl, Western Kingbird, Warbling Vireo, Brown-headed Nuthatch, Swainson's Warbler, Worm-eating Warbler, and Grasshopper Sparrow** are just a few of the birds that made the list. Without the overwhelming participation of club members, the results would have been much different, considering that, of the 113 species counted, 25 species appeared on only one list and 16 species appeared on only two lists. Over one-third of the total species were seen or heard by two or fewer persons or teams. As a reward for everyone's hard work, in a reversal of the phrase, "Eat, sleep, bird," a scrumptious "call-the-list" brunch was hosted by Ann McLaurin and Lynne Fitzgerald on Sunday.

Participating in the Challenge were Linda Adrion, Jerry Bertrand, Rhonda Clay, Colleen Cookson, Lynn Fitzgerald, Dennis Forshee, Sarah and Bill Hancock, Hubert and Pat Hervey, Shirley Huss, Jim Ingold, John McBride, Ann McLaurin, Nancy Menasco, Dorothy and Bob Metzler, Lily Poole, Larry Raymond, Rosana Shelby, Sharon and Heather Spaulding, Tom Walker, and Elaine Wilson.

A plaque will be presented by representatives of the Northeast Bird Club to the Bird Study Group at our September meeting. In the future, the plaque will reside with the winning club for that year. The Bird Study Group is determined to keep the plaque in Shreveport, but the Northeast Bird Club is just as determined to have the plaque make the eastward journey on I-20 to Monroe. We have taken their measure and they have taken ours; neither club has been found wanting. Next year's competition will be even tougher. Will you be ready?

Boy Scout Bird Study Badge

The BSG was once again contacted by the Boy Scouts of America to help conduct the Bird Study Badge training at their summer camp, which is held annually during June at the Garland Scout Ranch. Amanda Crnkovic and I volunteered to help with the two summer sessions.

Amanda and I went to Garland Ranch to scout out birds we might see. Rain had made the camp road so muddy we decided to park our cars at the Ranger's house and slish our way down to the camp lodge. Along the way we saw **Great Blue Heron, Turkey Vulture, Mourning Dove, White-eyed Vireo, Red-eyed Vireo, Carolina Chickadee, and Carolina Wren**.

In the first session Amanda had three students. A Boy Scout counselor, named H.P., was very helpful and assisted during both sessions. Amanda taught her group general bird information. The scouts also practiced using a bird field guide. Amanda brought a wing and a few specimens of preserved birds to show the boys beak and feet types.

I had ten boys in the second session of the class. We went over the badge requirement worksheet and then, despite an afternoon of drizzling rain and thunder, I took the boys on a short bird walk. We had a nice bunch of kids, all of whom were interested in the class, and had some great discussions about birds and birding.

The Least Tern Population Dives

On the nine trips of the annual U. S. Army Corps of Engineers survey, 74 adult **Least Terns** were found to have produced only three fledglings on the Red River in Louisiana in 2004. The survey covered Pools 2, 3, 4, and 5 of the Red River from mile-marker 100 south of Boyce in Rapides Parish to mile-marker 244, Cat Island, in northern Bossier Parish. A new colony was found one mile north of Boyce at mile-marker 108.3 built on dredge material deposited this spring. This colony is 32 miles farther downriver than the southernmost colony previously reported, St. Maurice Island in Natchitoches Parish. The Boyce colony is on the northeastern side of the river, surrounded by Grant Parish, but is historically known to have been on the southwestern side of the river in Rapides Parish. The Boyce colony raised the only juvenile terns in the entire survey area, a total of three chicks. Other colonies attempted to nest at Powhatan and Cash Point islands. The Powhatan colony was on a fully attached sandbar and failed due to unknown land

predators. Coyote tracks were seen. The Cash Point island colony failed due to human recreation on the site.

The table below shows yearly comparisons for all five pool areas combined of the Red River. The totals are the highest counts for those months. June is used in 2003 because many birds left the area after the high water the first week of July.

The catastrophic nesting failure in 2004 was mostly due to high river levels. June of 2004 was the fourth wettest June in Shreveport history. As water levels remained high all month, the terns just sat around, ate fish, courted, and waited for dry land to emerge. The few attempts to nest were totally wiped out by heavy rains in Arkansas, East Texas, and Louisiana, which caused the river to rise eight feet or more. The only surviving nests were two at Boyce Island, which produced the three juveniles seen in August. Two of these were fledged and one was two days old. The two nests survived the flood because they were placed atop dredged piles, but were bare inches above the flood crest.

Boyce Island is mentioned in my article (J. LA Ornith 5(1): 2, 2001), but only as anecdotal historical evidence, that Least Terns have nested there in the past. I have visited the island every year since 1996 and never saw a tern in the area.

I also surveyed, with Pat Hervey, the area from the Arkansas state line to Shreveport. On August 15th we found 22 adult **Least Terns** in two colonies. The old colony locations studied in 1999 are becoming overgrown with vegetation to some extent and don't have as much desirable sandy habitat as I expected. One new colony location was found just north of the LA 2 bridge. This island is unattached, sandy and large, thus giving hopes for being a successful location for years to come.

The high waters wiped out the tern colonies in 2004 from Fulton, Arkansas, to Boyce, Louisiana. But, **Least Terns** should have had a successful nesting season in Texas, Oklahoma, and west of US 71 in Arkansas. This is in contrast to the lack of success system-wide in 2003, when rains in southern and south-central Oklahoma

caused a four-foot rise along the entire downstream length of the river.

The best news is the U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service, in the person of Bill Vermillion, made the entire survey with us. He has now seen the habitat problems first hand and I look forward to some pro-active management on behalf of the **Least Terns** in the near future.

Beginning Birders – Dennis Forshee will conduct beginning birder classes in the fall.

Field Trips – Nancy Menasco reported that BSG members identified 113 species of birds for the North Louisiana Birding Challenge on May 29. She said that Gerry Click thinks that the Monroe club will tally between 105 and 110 species after all of the data is considered. He will have the final tally next weekend. Nancy also said that the breeding warbler field trip would leave from Whataburger next Saturday and that the NABA Butterfly Count will take place on June 13. Nancy also suggested that when field trip leaders turn in data for their trips, they also include their names so that they may be contacted.

Membership – Lily Poole reported 104 paid accounts. Dennis Forshee suggested that we put a membership application in the Wild Bird Center newsletter.

Web Site – Lily Poole reported that Barney Poole has acquired the top level domain name for \$34.99 for one year. He is looking for someone to host the site. Barney will get more information before the next meeting.

New Officers – A motion was made to nominate the current officers to serve the next year. The proposed slate of officers was Lily Poole (president), Jerry Bertrand (vice-president), Jean Trahan (treasurer), and Jeff Trahan (secretary). The motion was seconded and approved by the board.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting

June 8, 2004, 7:00 p.m.

Museum of Life Sciences at LSU

Program – BSG member Jeff Trahan gave a presentation on getting started in butterflying.

Treasurer's Report – Jean Trahan gave the treasurer's report. For the month ending May 31, the club had \$2,705.98 in the bank. In addition, we had \$182.64 and \$882.44 in prepaid expenses at the post office and LSU printing, respectively. The fund balance is \$3,771.06. Jean also learned that it would cost \$1.41 to mail one copy of the *Hot Spots* publication. She suggested that we could charge \$2.00 for shipping and handling.

Field Trips – Nancy Menasco reported on upcoming field trips. The North American Butterfly Association 4th of July Butterfly Count will take place June 13. We will have a birding scavenger hunt this summer, but plans for this are not yet complete. Nancy said that she wants to line up as many boats as possible to have a field trip to the Red River for the Lower Mississippi Valley Shorebird Count.

Nominating Committee – Inadvertently, Nancy Menasco was not elected to the board at the last meeting. A motion was made to elect Nancy to the board and was approved by the membership.

BIRD REPORT – compiled August 24, 2004

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer's initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.

Report bird records for the newsletter to Mac Hardy by the 15th of each month. All bird records reported here are observations of the observers and are therefore the responsibility of the observer.
