Sri Lanka Birding

JANUARY PROGRAM

When: Tuesday, January 11, 6:30 p.m.

Where: LSU in Shreveport, Museum of Life Sciences

In July of 2004, Mac and Marilyn Hardy spent three weeks touring the island of Sri Lanka. The trip was a preliminary expedition for a possible future Discovery Tour to be offered by the American Museum of Natural History. During this trip they traveled in a small group around the entire country (except the northeastern coast, because of civil unrest in that area) observing wildlife.

This presentation will discuss the habitat, customs, and the endemic birds of Sri Lanka, including some aspects of biodiversity, evolution, and avian diversity. The impact of the tsunami disaster will be considered.

Close Encounters of the Owl Kind

On December 16, 2004, the inaugural Claiborne Christmas Bird Count was held with a special focus on nocturnal birds. After being shut out on owls on the 2003 test count, except for three **Eastern Screech-Owls** (one each for three of the teams), ME Lewis and her various birding associates had made a determined effort over the past year to locate owls in Claiborne Parish, especially in the area within the count circle. Success came in stages. Jerry Bertrand built an owl box for ME

and erected it in May. It wasn't long before a red-phase **Eastern Screech-Owl** took up residence; ME saw it peering out at her one day while she was working in the garden. That first owl brought company as since then, as many as three screech-owls at a time have been heard calling to each other in ME's woods.

The next breakthrough came in early August. ME and husband Fred live on the Lake Claiborne inlet known as Bear Creek. One of ME's neighbors, Bob Robinson, whose property borders the main part of the lake, called "the big lake" by Claibornites, told ME an owl was visiting his yard most evenings. Several of us birders were visiting about that time and Bob promised to call if the owl appeared. The call came during the middle of dinner; we abandoned our plates, grabbed our binoculars, and raced for the car. Sure enough, a **Barred Owl** was perched in one of Bob's trees.

The night before the 2003 test count, Rosemary Seidler had heard a **Great Horned Owl** across the lake in the distance, but despite our diligent searching in the tall trees left in the cutover areas along Arizona Road, trees and poles at the North Louisiana Hill Farm Experiment Station and in the few pastures to be found in Claiborne Parish, no others had been heard or seen since. Finally, early one morning in September, during a visit to attend the annual Haynesville Butterfly Festival, ME and I joined Linda Adrion and Janis Harrison on the porch of the guest house. Linda and Janis told us they'd heard a **Great Horned Owl** in the woods next to the guest house. Before long, ME and I heard it too, bringing the total owl species found at or near ME's to three species.

ME is fast becoming known as the "Birdwoman of Claiborne Parish" – we're thinking of getting her a bumper sticker – and a growing network of friends, acquaintances, friends of friends, and acquaintances of acquaintances keep her apprised of the birds they're seeing. ME even has her forester looking, but a **Barn Owl** had not been reported by the time of the 2004 Christmas Bird Count.

The Claiborne Christmas Bird Count is somewhat unique in that most of the participants spent the night before the count *within* the count circle in various Lake Claiborne-side lodgings provided by co-compiler, ME and husband Fred, including ME's house and guest house and a friend's cabin down the road. By 5:00 a.m. on count day, almost everyone was stirring and Area #1 team members, ME, Jerry, and I had the advantage of waking up already in our count territory. As I hastily donned layer upon layer of clothing to protect against the pre-dawn chill, I felt a little like Ralphie's little brother in the movie, *A Christmas Story*, who, after his mother stuffs him into his snowsuit, wails through the

layers of scarf wrapped around his head and face that he can't put his arms down. Outside ME was playing a screech-owl tape. An answering whinny came immediately. Jerry was feeling under the weather and decided he would wait until later to join us, so ME and I headed out alone to look for Bob Robinson's **Barred Owl**.

A light mist was falling as we drove away. Bob hadn't seen the **Barred Owl** in his yard for awhile, but he told us to check out a wet, bottomland area along his road. The first place we stopped yielded no results so we drove further along to the bottom of the bottoms. ME had opened the moon roof in her vehicle. We got out; I turned on the tape player and set it on top of the SUV at the edge of the moon roof. We stood in the darkness looking and listening but heard nothing except the screech-owl calling on the tape. I reached up to turn off the tape player and felt something grip my hand. Startled, to say the least, as I snatched my hand back, knocking the tape player onto the seat of the car, I looked up to catch a glimpse of the outstretched wings of a **Barred Owl**.

My late mama would have been proud of me. I did not say "#?!&!?!#&?"; I simply said, "Oh, my gosh!" Although the owl must have flown right over her, all ME heard was the tape player falling and thought from my exclamation that it must have fallen on the concrete. She came around to my side of the car and I showed her my left hand by flashlight. There were two long scratches on top of my hand and I was bleeding from a couple of slight punctures in the web of my thumb and forefinger. The wounds mainly stung but knowing that the better part of valor is discretion, an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure, etc., etc., etc., we decided to return to the house and doctor the wounds with peroxide and antiseptic cream. ME also photographed the injuries as documentation just in case someone hearing the story might think we were joshing. We returned to our birding having learned that if you're going to use a tape player on top of your car to bring in owls in the dark, you'd best be wearing heavy gloves when you go to retrieve said tape player just in case you too have a close encounter of the owl kind.

But there were more owls still to come that day. In late afternoon, we arrived back at ME's with Jim Ingold. We went inside to put our stuff down and as we came back out, Jim Ingold told us to listen. Not one but two **Great Horned Owls** were hooting in ME's woods. In a last-ditch count effort, Jerry and I took a walk along what we laughingly called the beach near ME's house. Lake Claiborne is drawn down from September of 2004 through mid-January of 2005 for purposes of seawall and dock repairs. The receding waters have exposed a

sizeable portion of land but this so-called beach has no resemblance to anything one would picture when thinking of a beach. As we walked, across the lake, another **Great Horned Owl** called.

Of course, one of the big stories at the call-the-list supper was the **Barred Owl** encounter. Jim Ingold told us that owls fly so silently that we wouldn't have heard it coming if the tape player had been off. Mac Hardy said it was unlikely that it was just a coincidence that the owl and I reached for the tape player at the same time; rather, the owl was watching, waiting for the "screech-owl" making the sound to move. When I put my hand up, it attacked. I was standing off the road on the right hand side of the vehicle and the owl had to have been perched in the woods across the road on ME's side. The owl's reaction time and speed really impresses me as I had only had my hand on the tape player a moment when I felt the owl's talons.

Count participants Jeff and Jean Trahan added another **Eastern Screech-Owl** and another **Great Horned Owl**; Jim Ingold and the team of Rosemary Seidler, Linda Adrion, and Vicki LeFevers each contributed an **Eastern Screech-Owl**; and the team of Amanda Crnkovic, Mac Hardy, and Janis Harrison found another **Barred Owl** for a total of four **Eastern Screech-Owls**, four **Great Horned Owls**, and two **Barred Owls**. No owls have been found yet in the area covered by Sterling and Loice Lacy and Pat Bates, which includes Homer and the Hill Farm, and **Barn Owl** continues to be elusive but with the help of ME's Claiborne Parish bird alert network, the Claiborne Christmas Bird Count of 2005 will report all four owl species.

8th ANNUAL GREAT BACKYARD BIRD COUNT

Cornell Lab of Ornithology and the National Audubon Society

The 8th annual Great Backyard Bird Count invites everyone to go out and count for the bird's in America's great backyard.

During the weekend of February 18 through 21, people across the North American continent are encouraged to count the birds in their backyards and report them over the Internet, as part of the Great Backyard Bird Count (GBBC), one of the world's largest volunteer efforts of its kind. In addition to its value as a research study, the GBBC allows people of all ages and background to celebrate birds and provide vital information about North America's birds.

This is the eighth year of the popular event, developed and managed by the Cornell Lab of Ornithology and the National Audubon Society, with sponsorship from Wild Birds Unlimited storeowners.

This year's theme, "North America's Great Backyard," was chosen as a way to celebrate the unique beauty and birds found across the continent. "We call it the Great Backyard Bird Count to make the point that anyone can participate," says John Fitzpatrick, director of the Cornell Lab of Ornithology. "But really, a 'backyard' can be anywhere you happen to be—a schoolyard, a local park, the balcony of a high rise apartment, a wildlife refuge. For this year's Great Backyard Bird Count, Cornell and Audubon, along with these federal agencies, are encouraging families and individuals to visit their local national wildlife refuge, national forest, national park, and other federal wild lands, in addition to reporting the birds they see in their own backyard. No matter where you go in this 'Great Backyard,' you're almost certain to find birds in all their beauty. By participating in the Great Backyard Bird Count, you can help researchers better understand bird population numbers and distribution across the continent." People are encouraged to enjoy the birds around them by going out into the "Great Backyard" during any or all of the count days and keeping track of the highest numbers of each bird species they see. People then report their sightings over the Internet at www.birdsource.org/gbbc.

Researchers hope that by learning more about the birds and habitats in their own backyards, families will decide to become part of Project FeederWatch, a winterlong survey of birds that visit feeders. FeederWatch data have been instrumental in our scientific analyses of winter finch movements and Varied Thrush cycles, and have even helped researchers discover a new avian disease, mycoplasmal conjunctivitis, or House Finch eye disease. These findings were possible thanks to dedicated FeederWatchers.

"Taking part in the Great Backyard Bird Count takes as little or as much time as participants wish," says Audubon's director of citizen science Paul Green. "The important thing is to just take part, count for the birds, and enjoy North America's Great Backyard."

Instructions for participating can be found at www.birdsource.org/gbbc. There's no fee or registration. Those who would like to participate but who aren't online can try their local library.

The BSG will be participating in the Great Backyard Bird Count again this year. Look for details in the February newsletter.

Hardy and Hervey Honored by BSG

At this year's Christmas auction and banquet, held on December 14, 2004, I had the honor of presenting two Bird Study Group awards, the Will Smolenski Lifetime Service Award to Mac Hardy and the first President's Award to Hubert Hervey.

The Lifetime Service Award is named after its first recipient, Will Smolenski. The recipient of the award must have served as an officer, board member, committee chair and/or in another significant capacity for a minimum of ten years and must have made significant contributions to the Bird Study Group or have had a major positive influence in the success of the Bird Study Group.

Mac has been a BSG member since the beginning. He has served the group as President, officer, board member, trip leader, Hot Spots editor, and Bird Records coordinator. Mac also does the countless other jobs that are always done, without being asked to do them. The task of maintaining and compiling the bird records is a function that alone deserves recognition. The BSG database has over 156,000 records. This makes ours a highly valuable scientific resource that Mac takes very seriously as a function of the BSG and as a contribution to science. If you can think of a BSG event, job, or function that Mac hasn't done I bet he would readily volunteer to do it. That is the kind of service that Mac gives the BSG.

Mac is an excellent birder and has always acted with the best intent to promote birding and the BSG. I have been fortunate to come into birding with Mac as my mentor. I have birded with him on field trips, on bird counts, in foreign countries, and even while pulling through the fast food drive through. He is always ready with BSG brochure for any interested person he may meet. He does things for the BSG that no one knows about or notices. He does them for the good of the group, without a thought as to thanks. The BSG board awarded Mac Hardy our Lifetime Service Award for his commitment and service to the BSG.

The purpose of the President's Award is to recognize persons, families, companies, and/or organizations that enhance or take special measures to promote birding and/or the Bird Study Group in northwestern Louisiana. This year the BSG awarded its first President's Award to Hubert Hervey.

Hubert Hervey has promoted the BSG and birding in northwestern Louisiana. He has served the BSG as President, officer, board member, trip leader, count coordinator, Hot Spots contributor, and auctioneer. Anyone who has ever been on a birding outing with

Hubert knows that he is not only an excellent birder, but for the rest of us, he adds much to the birding experience. Hubert deserves to receive the President's award not only because of his service to the BSG but also his commitment to saving the **Interior Least Tern**. His dedication to monitoring this species' plight on the Red River should serve as an inspiration to the rest of us. He has motored up and down the Red River in the hottest part of the year and still found the motivation to face the bureaucracy that control's the tern's survival. His research has resulted in a peer-reviewed scientific paper in the *Louisiana Journal of Ornithology*. I think the BSG is a better organization by having Hubert as a member and the BSG board agreed that we should recognize his efforts with this year's BSG President's Award.

Any member of the Bird Study Group can make nominations for these awards. Nominations for next year's awards should be submitted in writing to the BSG's Board of Directors.

BIRD REPORT – compiled December 30, 2004

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer's initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds they observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.
