Come out to the Hervey farm in Stonewall and watch for migrating raptors on their way south for the winter. An annual event, the hawk watch has produced as many as 650 migrating raptors in an afternoon. If they are particularly numerous this year, we'll stay until the birds have stopped moving. Details on food are TBA.

Directions: Go south on Linwood Road. Go a couple of miles into DeSoto Parish, pass a convenient store on the left and turn right onto Ranchette Road. Go one mile, turn left at the T. This is Missile Base Road. Go almost a mile and turn left over the cattle guard that

enters the farm. The sign says Hervey Dairy Road. The Hervey house is the first house on the left at the top of the hill.

THE BIG SIT!

Sunday, October 10, 2010

Who can attend: The public is invited. Admission is free. **NO PETS PLEASE!**

What to bring: Binoculars, field guides, scope, chair, hat, drinks, food, mosquito repellent, and sunscreen.

Hosted by *Bird Watcher's Digest* magazine, the Big Sit is an annual, international, noncompetitive birding event. 2010 will mark the 16th Annual Big Sit. Sitters count birds observed or heard from within a 17-foot diameter circle. Sitters may come and go at will. Beginning birders are very welcome.

This is the first time a Big Sit will be held at the refuge Bayou Pierre Unit, which is located about 30 minutes south of Shreveport along the Red River and just off LA 1 in Red River Parish. Made up of three tracts totaling almost 4,000 acres, the Bayou Pierre Unit includes moist soil impoundments, which are flooded annually to provide habitat for migrating shorebirds, wading birds, and wintering waterfowl; bottomland hardwoods along the river; reforestation areas; and a cypress-tupelo swamp. Also located on the unit is an old farmhouse that is being renovated by the Friends of Red River NWR to serve as a visitor contact, education, and research center. Restrooms are available onsite.

Directions to the Bayou Pierre Unit:

From the intersection of Youree Drive/LA 1 and Bert Kouns Loop in Shreveport, go south on Youree Drive/LA 1 for 27.7 miles. Turn left (east) on Grand Bayou Loop/PR 401 and proceed 0.7 mile. You will see the Red River NWR sign and a white house on your left. Turn in the driveway at the gate and park by the house. This is about a 35-minute drive. Additional information: The turn on to Grand Bayou Loop/Parish Road 401 is 1.6 miles south on LA 1 from the blinking caution light

at the intersection of LA 1 and LA 509 in Red River Parish.

Join us as we celebrate northwestern Louisiana's own Red River National Wildlife Refuge and the other 551 national wildlife refuges that make up America's 150-million-acre National Wildlife Refuge System! The 6th Annual Celebration will again feature live hawks and owls, herps and baby alligators, nature walks and hayride refuge tours, fishing games and nature projects for children, face painting, native plants exhibits and sales, the popular interactive Be A Bear obstacle course that follows a year in the life of a bear, and many other fun nature-oriented activities. In the works are some new activities as well. Of course, you won't want to miss the free catfish lunch.

October is Archaeology month in Louisiana and returning to the Refuge Celebration will be an exhibit on local prehistoric Native Americans use of the landscape, including a hands-on demonstration of Native American tools, sponsored by the Northwest Chapter of the Louisiana Archaeological Society and the Bossier Parish Library Historical Center.

This year's Art in Nature exhibit will feature local student entries in our first "Louisiana's Natural Treasures" art contest. Directions to the Headquarters Unit:

From the intersection of US 71 (Barksdale Boulevard) and Jimmie Davis Highway (LA 511) in Bossier City, go south about one-half mile on US 71 and turn right (west) on Sunflower Road. Proceed to the end of the road through the gate into the refuge. The Refuge is open to walk-in visitors daily during daylight hours.

Big Changes for BSG Newsletter

Birds and the Bird Study Group thrive better in a green environment. The BSG will do its part toward a more ecologically sustainable world by reducing our footprint on the earth; we will make our newsletter available on our web site (www.birdstudygroup.org) and stop producing a paper newsletter. The transition will begin with the October newsletter (volume 25, number 2). At the September board meeting (September 7, 2010) of the BSG a motion to move to an on-line newsletter passed unanimously.

There are many positive reasons to make such a change for the BSG. 1) It will reduce our cost of producing a newsletter from about \$137 a month to about \$13, or less, a month. We will continue to mail a printed copy to those members who do not have e-mail addresses (the \$13 cost). 2) It will reduce our use of paper to almost nothing. 3) It will reduce the work load for our volunteers from approximately 12 man-hours per month to about 2. 4) It will reduce the time delay to deliver the finished newsletter to you from 3-5 days to a few minutes. 5) It will allow us to provide you with a much more attractive newsletter that can contain color photographs and art work that were too expensive for the printed copy. 5) It will also allow us to send the electronic newsletter to many more birders. 6) It will

allow us to use the saved funds for other education and conservation projects.

Many other organizations have already taken such steps. For a few months we will continue to print a few paper copies for those of you who do not have e-mail. This newsletter was published on the web site several days before it arrived in your mail. The web version is a PDF file that requires Adobe Reader (or some other similar program) to view. Adobe Reader is completely seamless to install and use on your computer; it probably is already on your computer. To see our newsletter on the web type the BSG address (www.birdstudygroup.org) in your web browser window and navigate to our site. On the front page of the BSG web site you will see a link to the current newsletter and a link to download Adobe Reader (it is free), if you need the reader.

Let us know your response to this change. We hope you will like the new, modern, more attractive look of the BSG Newsletter. Please e-mail new or updated addresses (e-mail and land) to lhardy@lsus.edu.

BIRD REPORT – compiled September 3, 2010

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer’s initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds they observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.

Report bird records for the newsletter to Mac Hardy by the 25th of each month. All bird records reported here are observations of the observers and are therefore the responsibility of the observer.

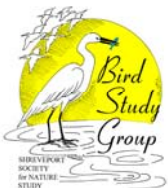

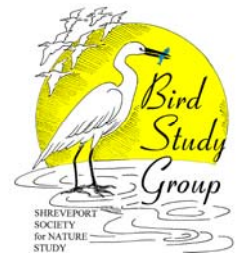

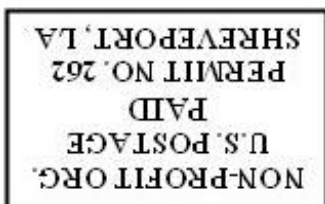
