## The Backyard Birder

I love my backyard birding area even if it is any eye sore to most neighbors. I have fifteen feeding stations for my birds. In fact, I'm quite the "gadget guru" when it comes to feeding the birds.

Last summer while on a trip to Little Rock, Arkansas, I purchased a hummingbird "leaf mister." A needed attachment to my bird bath dripper. The salesman easily hooked me when he said the magic words, "This will attract different varieties of little birds!" I left the bird store

thinking I must be the biggest sucker he has ever seen, but in my heart, I knew I really needed it!

The "gadget" sat in my garage for a full month till I could muster the courage to assemble the "darn thing that I just had to have." Well, to my surprise and astonishment it only took about 15 minutes to put up. I tied the spout of the mister to a branch of a mimosa sapling that has grown up closely to one of the windows of my sunroom. I

tied the small black rubber hose of the mister to the trunk tree with the twist ties that came with the gadget. It is indeed a tacky "do-hickey," as my daughter has termed it.

However, to my surprise and ultimate delight, within five minutes of turning the water on I had a beautiful male **Ruby-throated Hummingbird** bathing contentedly within the fine mist of my "tacky gadget"! By the end of the day the misting water, falling into my bird bath below, had attracted quite a crowd of not only birds but people. Several neighbors pulled up lawn chairs to watch the fascinating sight of all the little hummers attracted to the mist as well as many other common backyard birds. My mister has become the major bird attraction in the neighborhood.

Now, each day I drink my morning coffee in the sunroom window watching curiously to see what new little bird I might have as a visitor. My list from last summer includes your normal visitors such as **House Finches, Ruby-throated Hummingbirds, Northern Mockingbirds, Northern Cardinals, and Blue Jays**. Yet it has grown to include **Carolina Chickadees, Baltimore Oriole, Brown Thrasher, Nashville Warbler, Dickcissel, Carolina Wren, Yellow-rumped Warbler, and Northern Parula** to name a few. Plus, a **Loggerhead Shrike** has decided the mister area makes a great feeding station!

This summer I'm sure will bring many backyard birding surprises, since the mister has become part of my birding landscape. The leaf mister has already brought in a kinglet, **Yellow-bellied Sapsucker, Cedar Waxwing**, and flocks of **American Goldfinches** this spring. I guess I'll need to make another trip to the bird store to see what else is new!

The leaf mister was purchased at Wild Birds Unlimited in Little Rock, Arkansas. It is made by Avian Aquatics, Bird Bathing Products, and the store model number is 7386. I paid \$35.95 at the birding store; however, the company address is Avian Aquatics, Inc., 6 Point Circle, Lewes, DE 19958. Their phone number is (302) 645-8643. They might be able to give you a better price.

## 1996 MIGRATORY BIRD COUNT RESULTS

We had wonderful participation by the birds for this May 11, 1996 NAMC. All seven groups reported great birding. This was partly due to the weather. A wet, cool front moved through our area about dawn, with thunderstorms which ended by early morning. The ground was wet and water was pooled in the fields. Such unusual birds for our area as **Willet**, **Baird's Sandpiper**, and **Dunlin** were observed because of these advantageous weather conditions. Twenty-two warbler species were seen including, **Chestnut-sided**, **Blackburnian**, **Tennessee**, **Wilson's** and **Canada**.

An amazing eleven flycatcher and kingbird species were totalled. This includes vocal identification of several difficult Empidonax flycatchers by Jim Ingold. This list includes **Olive-sided**, **Yellow-bellied**, **Acadian**, **Willow**, and **Least**, plus those species we expect to see and one never seen here before. That bird will apparently have to remain as a choice between **Tropical** and **Couch's Kingbird**. The visual distinction between these two species is so limited that the call or song of the bird in question must be heard before a positive determination can be made. We did not hear the bird and so it must remain **Tropical/Couch's Kingbird**. The odds would seem to favor it being a **Couch's Kingbird** judging by the nesting area being nearer to our

state. It was found by Hubert Hervey and Pat Hervey two miles west of Keatchie, La. on La. 172. Identification assistance was received from Horace Jeter and Charlie Lyon, who photographed the bird. It was not located the next day.

As you will see by the tables printed below this was our best year by a total of 13 species. We will have to go some to beat this record. I am sure this is the highest single day outing our club has ever had: **130 species** in Caddo Parish, **132 species** adding DeSoto and Caddo Parishes.

A special thanks to Larry and Anne Raymond for their hospitality by letting us gather at their home and feeding us after the NAMC was completed.

## WHITE-FACED IBIS: NEW AREA BIRD

Six **White-faced Ibis** were sighted on May 4, 1996, two and one-half miles south of McDade, Bossier Parish, Louisiana by several Bird Study Group members who were on the way to Caroline Dorman's Briarwood Nature Preserve. Hubert and Pat Hervey and Will Smolenski stopped on the return trip at a slough on the east side of U. S. 71. The birds had remained there feeding until 1:30 pm and completely ignored us as we viewed them with binoculars and a scope. The white faced feature showed up very clearly. These dark

birds are actually very colorful when well seen in the spring and summer, with shades of rich maroon intermingled with glossy purple and green. The legs were reddish. One of our

members has an old record of **White-faced Ibis** here in the spring but this is the first record for our data base.
