UPCOMING FIELD TRIPS AND EVENTS

What to bring on field trips: binoculars, two-way radios, scope, if you have one, snacks, and drinks. Unless otherwise noted, field trips will take place rain or shine, so bring rain gear if the weather's threatening.

MIGRATION MYSTERY TOUR

Shorebirds, warblers, who knows what we might find! LSUS Museum of Life Sciences - Symposium

The Museum of Life Sciences at LSU in Shreveport is holding the Inaugural Symposium in its new Science Series on Tuesday 25 April 2006 in the Science Lecture Auditorium on the LSUS campus at 7:30 p.m. The symposium talk is open to the public and will be targeted to the non-science audience.

The symposium speaker will be Dr. Kurt M. Pickett of the American Museum of Natural History in New York City. Dr. Pickett is a 1990 graduate of Caddo Magnet High School in Shreveport and he graduated from the department of Biological Sciences at LSUS in 1996. He received both his Masters degree and his Ph.D. from The Ohio State University.

Dr. Pickett currently holds a Theodore Roosevelt fellowship at the American Museum of Natural History in the Division of Invertebrate Zoology. He is an expert on the evolution of social behavior in wasps.

The title of his symposium talk is: "Four billion years of altruism: From molecular alliance to superorganism."

On Monday 24 April he will be giving a talk to the students at LSUS at 11:00 a.m. also in the Science Lecture Auditorium. This talk will be geared more to a scientific audience but the public is still encouraged to attend. The title of the Monday morning talk is: "Testing behavioral scenarios: The phylogenetics of new world paper wasps, and the evolution of sociality."

BSG 2005 BIRDING COMPETITION – RESULTS

I volunteered to compile the results of the **BSG 2005 Birding Competition**. The competition had three categories: 1. **Parish List Competition** - total species count for 2005 for each parish in the BSG area, i.e., Bienville, Bossier, Caddo, Claiborne, DeSoto, Red River, Natchitoches & Webster, 2. **Life List Competition** - the total additions to the observer's world life list that were seen in the BSG area in 2005, and 3. **Golden Bird Competition** - A bird was randomly selected from all species reported and the names of all competitors who saw this bird will be placed in a drawing.

The awards for each competition were: **Parish List competition** - An impressive certificate and the honor and glory of having your name published as a winner in

the BSG newsletter. **Life list competition** - Your choice of one of the following: Sibley's Guide to Birds, Peterson Field Guides "Birding by Ear" or "More Birding by Ear" CD, or Thayer Birding Software/Cornell Lab of Ornithology "Birds of Louisiana" CD. **Golden Bird competition** - A contribution will be made in the name of the winner to the Louisiana birding or conservation association of the winner's choice.

And now for the winners. Only 3 members turned in records for the **Parish List Competition**: Hubert Hervey, Nancy Menasco, and Jim Ingold. The winner was Nancy Menasco with 212 total species seen in our reporting area in 2005, Hubert was second with 204 species and I was last with 175 species. Total species seen by each observer can be seen in Table 1.

Linda Adrion won the **Life List Competition** with eight species added to her life list in 2005. Her new birds were: 11 Jan **Calliope Hummingbird**, 3514 Fountainbleau, Keithville; 12 Jan **Barn Owl**, Gilliam Scott Slough Rd/LA2; 13 Feb **Rufous Hummingbird**, 6650 North Park Circle, Shreveport; 26 Apr **Swainson's Hawk**, Gilliam Scott Slough Rd/LA2; 21 May **Grasshopper Sparrow**, Gilliam Levee Rd; 26 May **American Woodcock**, 720 Prospect St., Shreveport; 14 Aug **Wilson's Phalarope**, Red River NWR Bayou Pierre Unit; and 17 Sep **Merlin**, Gilliam Scott Slough Rd/LA2; 25 Sep **Gull-billed Tern**, on the Red River. Nancy Menasco was the only other birder to turn in life list records. Her new birds were all seen in Caddo Parish and included: **Gull-billed Tern**, **Calliope Hummingbird**, and **Grasshopper Sparrow**.

For the **Golden Bird Completion**, I made a numbered list of all the species seen during the year by Nancy, Hubert and myself. The list contained 245 species. During the March Bird Study Group meeting Ron Martin pulled a number from a container with pieces of paper numbered from 1 to 245. Number 215 was selected which corresponded with Fox Sparrow. All

three participants had the Fox Sparrow on their lists so they will together select which organization gets the donation.

BIRD REPORT – *compiled April 10, 2006*

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer's initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds they observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.

Report bird records for the newsletter to Mac Hardy by the 15th of each month. All bird records reported here are observations of the observers and are therefore the responsibility of the observer.
