### NABA BUTTERFLY COUNT

This is the eighth annual North American Butterfly Association (NABA) count for Shreveport. Butterfly counts are very similar to bird counts. The 15-mile diameter count circle for the Shreveport count is centered on the intersection of Norris Ferry Road and Overton Brooks Road. This area includes much of southeastern Shreveport, Wallace Lake, Keithville, and a small portion of Bossier Parish. If you live within the

circle, you may participate by counting butterflies in your yard or you may count in a designated portion of the circle. Contact Jeff for forms and instructions. Participants will gather at the home of Jeff and Jean Trahan at 505 Americana in Shreveport at 6:00 p.m. for the count tally.

### SWAINSON'S HAWKS AND BIG DAY, 20 APRIL 2008

Hubert Hervey and Terry Davis set out early for a day of birding pleasure. By the time we finished our day had totaled 132 species of birds. We birded in Caddo Parish, and finished up in Bossier Parish. The biggest excitement for the day was locating 35 **Swainson's Hawks** in northern Caddo Parish. They were scattered out along the Red River valley farmlands from Sentell Road to near Missionary Plantation. Some of the hawks were on the plowed ground; some were feeding, some took flight as we approached and often soared up into the skies and disappeared to the north. The total of 35 **Swainson's Hawks** is the highest in the Bird Study Group data base. Previous high counts are 19 SWHA

John McBride et al. Gilliam Levee Rd, Caddo Parish on April 17, 2005, and 14 SWHA Jeff and Jean Trahan, Robson Rd, Caddo Parish on May 1 2005. All other records are for one to three birds and are from Caddo, DeSoto and Red River Parishes. All records are during spring migration except two in early October during fall migration and one record that Pat and I had on August 15, 2004 of two birds perched in trees by the Red River north of the Highway 2 Bridge, suggesting the possibility of a nesting population in north Louisiana .

I also suspect that 132 species in one day is a pretty decent number for a two parish Big Day. We started in Bossier City, Stoner Woods, Cross Lake, then north to Dixie, up the River Road to Missionary Plantation on Arkansas line, the crossed over to Wardview area to finish up the afternoon. We had only four duck species, all the bitterns and herons except **Tricolored Heron**, ten raptors, eight sandpipers, four doves, four vireos, seventeen warblers, and nine sparrow species. There were good movements of **Eastern Kingbirds**, **Indigo Buntings**, **Yellow-rumped Warblers**, **Warbling Vireos**, **Nashville Warblers**, and **Lark Sparrows**. New arrivals included **Dickcissels**, several warbler species, **Painted Buntings**, **American Bittern**, three **Least Bitterns**, and **Yellow-breasted Chats**. Late lingering species were **Northern Harrier**, **Virginia Rail**, **Sora** in large numbers (34), **Brewer’s Blackbird**, and **Swamp Sparrow**. Best birds not yet mentioned included **Black-crowned Night-Heron**, **Osprey**, both yellowlegs, **Sprague’s Pipit** (8), **Golden-winged Warbler**, **Tennessee Warbler**, **Prairie Warbler**, **Swainson’s Warbler**, and **Grasshopper Sparrow** (6) at the sod farm. An Osprey flew by The Cove on Cross Lake with a yellow bass (sand bass), it perched in a tree, and was then harassed by **Fish Crows**, and relocated several times. The complete list has been entered in the BSG data base.

Hubert Hervey said that he and Terry Davis saw a **White-tailed Kite**, three **Bald Eagles** and a **Swainson’s Warbler** in the Wardview area in north Bossier Parish Thursday. Mac Hardy reports **Great-horned Owls** calling nightly at his house. Ron Martin saw two **Mississippi Kites** yesterday.

**BIRD REPORT** – *compiled April 2, 2008*

Use the bird report to see what other birders have been seeing and where to go find the bird you want to see. Observers are abbreviated by the first and last initials. Dates and localities of observations are summarized under the observer's initials. Sightings are arranged by species. Following each species is a line of data in the following format: date, initials of the observer, number of birds observed, initials of another observer, number of birds they observed, etc. For the number of birds observed, a 1 is used for both 1 bird and for numbers not reported by the observer. For example: 01/12/99 BB 2 means that on January 12, 1999, BB saw two birds. Then by looking on the observer list, located after the sightings, you can determine that BB is Bob Birder and on 1/12/99 he was birding C. Bickham Dickson Park.

Report bird records for the newsletter to Mac Hardy by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. All bird records reported here are observations of the observers and are therefore the responsibility of the observer.

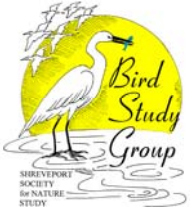
